From Bishop da Cunha's Pastoral Letter:

What Church will we leave behind?
Since 1990 in the Diocese of Fall River: 100,000 less Catholics attend Mass
There has been a 67% drop in Faith Formation
A 65% in the number of Sacraments of Initiation.

Bishop da Cunha: "How do we change these declines? First, we must work toward helping individuals experience metanoia-a personal conversion and change in one's way of life. This was a key aspect of Jesus' teachings and ministry, and it must also be a key aspect of our work as we move into the future."

"Have you truly committed to living in a way that when people encounter you, they will encounter Christ?" What needs to change?
