

MAPPING OUT THE JOURNEY

- CREATE an environment where your group members can connect and grow
- **SHARE** the plan with your Small Group. Ask members to bring an open mind and an open heart to group.
- INVITE someone to be a co-leader
- ASK members to prayerfully consider roles such as timers, host schedules, mission planners, social planner etc.
- **BEGIN** to cast the vision of the destination and share the excitement of anticipating a great trip.
- 1. What kind of environment do you envision for your Small Group? Consider: worship music, candles, journals, quiet time, respecting others time
- 2. Do you have a Co-Leader or other roles in your group? What kind of roles do you think will be important? Have members prayerfully discern their roles in the group.

 Consider: timer, host scheduler, mission planner, prayer leader
- 3. What vision or goals does your group have?



FUEL UP

- SHARE the Purpose of Group: To Make Disciples!
- PRAY before, during and after group
- Be their most AUTHENTIC self.
- . COMMIT to group by showing up.
